The Corvette Club meeting is on the third Thursday of each month, at the Lakewood Rod & Gun Club at 433 East Terrace Avenue in Lakewood, NY, at 7:00 pm. 

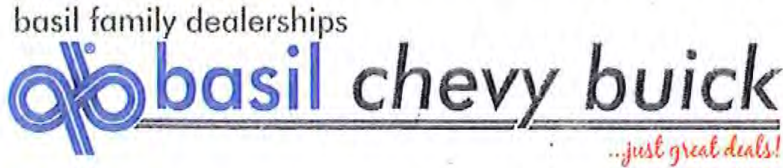
