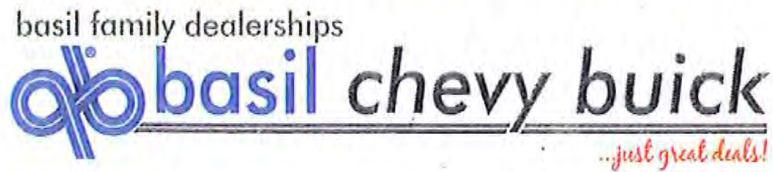





Dues are \$50.00 per year starting January 1st. However, if paid by January 31st, you only need to pay \$40.00. Dues paid after the 31st will be \$50.00. If you would like a hard copy of the monthly newsletter (Black & White only) there is an additional \$15.00 charged to cover this cost. A half year membership is \$30.00, and starts in July for new members only. Name tags (not included in membership dues) are \$5.50 each and are recommended. Members who have not paid their dues by March 31st will be removed from the Clubs Membership listing.

The Corvette Club meeting is on the second Thursday of each month, at the American Legion Post 777, at 26 Jackson Avenue at 7:30 pm. This location is just west of Sam's Club on Fairmount Avenue, Jamestown, N.Y. Check the club website for more information regarding the Club and meeting times and places.
